Programs - September 2024 - June 2025

Registration is now open for the following programs

■ Elementary

Classes are **in-person** on Saturday mornings from 9 to 11:30 a.m. and start on September 28, 2024.

■ Secondary

Classes are **offered virtually** on Saturday mornings from 8:45 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and begin on September 14, 2024. In order to participate in a virtual program, students will need to have access to a digital device and the internet.
